B. Outline and briefly describe the process of selection of entering medical students beginning with receipt of the application forms and ending with enrollment of the class. Cite all criteria for selection, (noting major ones) including cognitive, noncognitive, personal health and other information about the applicant.

After submitting the application form, the admissions committee makes one of the following decisions as the major criteria of the selection. 1. Applicant having a BSc. degree can be exempted 2. Other applicants have to take exam from biology and chemistry or physics. 2. Above 80% of the total score the applicant is admitted to the 1st year, between 60-79 % to the Basic Medical Course. Below 60% the applicant is rejected. Having fulfilled the requirements a letter of acceptance is given to the applicant immediately after the exam. The period and place of the enrollment is also announced . The medical certificate should be attached to application form. The letter of recommendation is welcomed.

Applicants are required to pay Application Processing and Entrance Examination fees. Payment of the fees must be received by the University before the interview in order to allow an applicant to sit for the Entrance Examination. The following documents are required to be submitted:

Certificate of Education (High School Diploma or Document of Graduation, any University/College Diploma for Certificates)

Birth Certificate and documentation of citizenship and/or permanent residence

Curriculum vitae

A legally notarized financial statement verifying that the applicant has sufficient financial resources to cover all tuition and education fees and living expenses for the planned duration of six or five years of the General Medicine and Dentistry programs respectively.

Medical Certificate (including documentation of immunizations and HIV /AIDS test confirming to Hungarian regulations. Failure to submit these documents will result in cancellation of registration.

3 recent passport photographs with the indication of the date when the pictures were taken.

Applicants may be admitted to the General Medicine and Dentistry Programs of the University without an entrance examination on the basis of the following degrees or studies: B.A. or B.Sci. degrees in natural science subjects or having studied biology, physics and chemistry at internationally recognized and listed foreign Colleges or Universities

teaching English language; International Baccalaureate diploma with at least a higher level and subsidiary level exam in two of the entrance examination subjects (biology, physics and chemistry) from a secondary school teaching in English language or having studied English as a Language A1 in an IB school. Applicants may be admitted to the Basic Medicine Course without an entrance examination on the basis of the following results and diplomas: High school diploma from accredited secondary school teaching in English language, a total score of at least 840 on the Scholastic Aptitude test (SAT) or a composite score of 17 or above the American College Testing Program (ACT) and/or minimum two A level examinations from biology, chemistry and physics. For applicants whose first language is not English, proof of English language ability is required: a minimum score of 600 on the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or an A or B level Cambridge Certificate of Proficiency in English (CPE).

E. Describe the process of selection of transfer students.

After submitting the application the Admissions Committee evaluates the grades curriculum of previous studies according to the corresponding paragraph of the Rules and regulations for English Program Students. The major points of this paragraph is that the transfer is possible to the 2nd, 3rd or 4th year and the average grade should be 3.00 or equivalent. Based on the equivalency of the submitted curriculum and the curriculum of the Faculty of Medicine the Committee makes the decision. In case of acceptance the Committee decides to which year the applicants may be transferred. The official transcript and curriculum from the previous studies should be submitted.
