The purpose of this letter of accreditation is to inform you of the action taken by the Liaison Committee on Medical Education (LCME) at its meeting of October 16-17, 2002, regarding the accreditation status of the University of British Columbia Faculty of Medicine, and to transmit to you the final report of the CACMS/LCME team that conducted a limited survey of the school on June 9-11, 2002.
