On September 5, 2002, the National Committee on Foreign Medical Education and Accreditation (NCFMEA) met in Washington, D.C., to review, among other things, the annual report submitted by the Council for Higher Education (Council) on the activities of its Committee for the Re-evaluation of Medical Schools (Re-evaluation Committee) in Israel.

The NCFMEA members wish to thank Professor Carmi Margolis from Ben Gurion University for attending the meeting as the official representative of the Council and providing additional information regarding the ongoing activities of the Re-evaluation Committee. At the meeting, the NCFMEA formally accepted the Council's report and also requested that the Council submit another report to the United States Department of Education for review at the spring 2004 NCFMEA meeting.

 - *Laws and Regulations:* Any changes in your country's laws or regulations affecting the re-evaluation of your medical schools.
 - *Standards, Processes and Procedures:* Any changes in the standards, processes or procedures that the Council and the Committee use to re-evaluate medical schools in your country.

Our mission is to ensure equal access to education and to promote educational excellence throughout the Nation.

- *Schedule of upcoming re-evaluation activities:* A listing of Council and Committee meetings and listing of on-site visits to medical schools and clinical clerkship sites planned for January - December 2004.
